Colonials Announce 2009 Season Schedule

The Morris County Colonials have announced their 8 game regular season schedule which sees the team face opposition from across the North East, as they enter their second season in the National Premier Soccer League (NPSL). The 2009 NPSL regular season will run from Mid-May through to early July before the National Playoffs and Championship final takes place in the first week of August.

The Colonials will kick off 2009 on Mat 17th with a scrimmage against the current National Champions; the Pennsylvania Stoners in what will be an early indication of how much the Colonials have improved since last summer. The Colonials will play their first league game 10 days later when they will host the New York Athletic Club on May 27th. The Colonials will then face the Boston Aztecs twice in quick succession, first hosting the Aztecs on May 31st before traveling to Amesbury, MA for the return game on June 6th. The Colonials will then continue traveling north to face the Maine Sting the following day, June 7th, before returning home to Morristown where they will again face the Sting on June 12th.

The Colonials will then head back out on the road to face two teams from New York. June 21st will see the Colonial's second game against the New York Athletic Club before heading to Long Island on June 24th for a tough test against the current Mid-Atlantic Division Champions, the Long Island Academy. The Colonials will end the regular season by hosting the Academy on July 8th.

After learning a lot in their first season, the Colonials head into 2009 aware of the difficulties they will need to overcome to improve on last years efforts. "There are some very good teams in the Conference that will provide stiff challenges for us" says Colonials Head Coach Rob Alman. "I am confident that our roster will be competitive and push us towards the playoff places." The Colonials roster, to be announced shortly, is expected to bring back the best of the 2008 team, with significant additions reflecting their status as the only top level amateur team in the north of the state.
