Millburn Magic Announce 2009 Season Schedule

The Millburn Magic have announced their 10 game regular season schedule which sees the team face opposition from across the North East, as they enter their second season in the Women's Premier Soccer League (WPSL). The 2009 WPSL regular season will run from Mid-May through to early July before the National Playoffs and Championship final takes place in the first week of August.

The Magic will kick off the 2009 season on May 17th in a repeat of last season's opener, hosting the Delaware Future at the [Dr Keith A. Neigel Stadium](#), Millburn, where they will be hoping to emulate last seasons 3-0 victory. The Magic will remain at home throughout May, hosting two teams from the North East Division, the New York Athletic Club on May 27th and the Boston Aztecs on the 31st in the first of back to back games between the two teams. The Magic travel to Boston for the return match just six days later, before continuing North to face the Maine Tide on June 7th.

The Magic will return to Millburn to host the Adirondack Lynx on June 10th before returning to the road to face two teams from New York. June 21st will see the Magic's second game against the New York Athletic Club before heading to Long Island on June 24th for a tough test against the current Divisional champions, the Long Island Fury. The Magic will play their final home game on July 1st, hosting the New England Mutiny before ending their season away at Philadelphia on July 8th, and early look at the group that will be joining the Women's Professional League in 2010.

After learning a lot in their first season, the Magic head into 2009 aware of the difficulties they will need to overcome to improve on last years 5th place finish. "There are some very good teams in the East Conference that will provide stiff challenges for us" says Magic Head Coach Andy Sones. "I am confident that our roster will be competitive and push for the play-off place." The Magic roster, to be announced shortly, is expected to bring back the best of the 2008 team, with significant additions reflecting their status as the only top level amateur team in the north of the state.
