### ***Opportunity knocks for Northern New Jersey Women Players***

Opportunity knocked for college players in Northern NJ today, as the Millburn Magic announced open tryout dates ahead of the 2008 Women's Premier Soccer League (WPSL) season. The Millburn-based team are the Northern New Jersey representatives of the WPSL, representing the highest level of amateur women's soccer in the United States.

Tryouts will be 12-2pm on Saturday, November 24<sup>th</sup>, and 12-2pm, on Saturday December 22<sup>nd</sup>, both at Millburn High School. With considerable interest already from players across the area, the first season promises to be an exciting one for the 2008 expansion team, playing at the beautiful Keith A. Neigel Stadium at Millburn High School. In addition to many talented players currently playing at Monmouth, TCNJ, Rutgers, Cornell, Loyola and Penn State (among others) who have registered an interest in playing, the team has been contacted by graduates, from Pennsylvania, California and abroad, who have moved into the area and are looking to continue play at the highest level. There are also a number of foreign-based players attending, including England goalkeeper Siobhan Chamberlain, recently back from the World Cup in China, and former England youth internationals Rachel Fell and Deena Rahman.

“The team will be a great mix of young talented players” said head coach Andy Sones, “it presents a fantastic opportunity for players in the area to compete against the best in the nation, and interest has been unbelievable”. The Magic will confirm a roster soon after the second tryout, early in January 2008.

The Millburn Magic is the Northern NJ member of the Women's Premier Soccer League, an independent national league representing the highest level of women's soccer in the United States. As an amateur league, our players are typically playing with high level college programs through the fall, and play with us from the middle of May through the start of August. The team plays in the Mid-Atlantic division of the East Coast Conference, with the five regional conference winners from around the country playing-off for the National Championship.
